




Dear Parents / Carers

We are pleased to offer the opportunity for a group of A Level Physicists to go on a trip to CERN in Geneva to visit the Large Hadron Collider. At CERN students will be shown two of the main sites where particle collisions are observed, visit exhibitions and listen to a lecture on the exciting world of particle physics. This is an integral part of the A Level course and will enable students to see how theory is put into practice and how international scientists all collaborate to further our understanding of the subatomic world.

The trip is due to leave on 23rd January 2025, the total cost for the trip is £570, students would require any personal spending money, lunch on Thursday which can be purchased at the airport and approximately £20 for lunch on the Friday which will be in the cafeteria in CERN. Please be warned it is very expensive in Switzerland, there is a small gift shop at CERN which does a modest range of souvenirs. The payment schedule for the trip is as follows:

- First, non-refundable deposit of £100 by 13th September 2024
- Second instalment of £100 by 30th September 2024
- Third instalment of £370 by 30th November 2024

All payments need to be made using the school's on-line Wisepay facility. Please make a note of your Wisepay receipt reference, as you will need to provide this on the attached medical form. Receipts are automatically generated on Wisepay and sent to the email address you supply when making the payment.

We will fly from Gatwick Airport and students will be taken by coach on Thursday 23rd January and will return by coach on Saturday 25th January at approximately 10pm. The costs allows for hand luggage only as we want to keep costs to a minimum. It is likely to be cold so layers will be important!


